- Allocate minimally, 1% of the entrepreneurs time to DESIGN work, every week.




DECLARE YOUR COMPANY'S QUEEN BEE ROLE



- Identify what makes your business distinct from the competition (this is your "brand promise").
- Identify the most important DOING action that your company must do to support that business distinction. Declare it as your QBR



POSITION YOUR COMPANY TO PROTECT AND SERVE THE QBR





- resources serving the company QBR. Trash/Transfer/Trim to alleviate distraction from QBR, and move work
- to appropriate skill levels.



CAPTURE SYSTEMS AND APPLY THE TRASH/TRANSFER/ TRIM METHOD

- Use capture processes to collect all company systems.
- Use <u>recording tools</u> to capture work as it is done.



BALANCE YOUR TEAM



- Match strongest team member traits to tasks that need it most.
- O Find additional/new right people when necessary.
- O Constantly seek and resolve new bottlenecks in the ACDC model.



DIRECT YOUR OFFERING TO A COMMUNITY



- Identify the customer base who is best served by your QBR (remember to align with your QBR, instead of pivoting alone).
- Constantly amplify and improve your "brand promise", which is served by your QBR.



DECLARE THE Y WEEK VACATION

- O Remove owner(s) from business to break dependency of the business on the owners.
- Use smaller vacations throughout your year to test + improve along the way to your ultimate 4 week vacation.
- Analyze and resolve failure points. Test again with subsequent 4 week vacations.
- You've achieved a **CLOCKWORK BUSINESS!**
